



## CALVARY LIFE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

**PASSAGE:** Genesis 11:1 – 9 ‘Tower of Babel’

**THEME/S:** Rebellion, redemption, worldly unity and Christian unity

1. How many languages can you speak? (How many languages could you order breakfast in?)
2. What was the nature of the rebellion that took place at Babel? How would you describe it?
3. In what ways is the sin at Babel still seen in the world today?
4. What does God’s divine intervention show us about His nature and character?
5. God’s judgment in scrambling and scattering can be seen as an act of mercy and restraint in keeping mankind from falling further into sin. How does God keep us from sin and how does He restrain the world from falling deeper into sin?
6. The answer to man’s rebellion is God’s redemption seen through the line of Messiah. With the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ and the giving of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, there was something of a reversal to what took place at Babel. Read Acts 2:1 – 12 and discuss the differences between Babel and Pentecost, worldly unity and Christian unity.
