



## CALVARY LIFE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

**PASSAGE:** Genesis 3:14 – 24

**THEME/S:** Curse, cure, Adam comparison

1. What effects of the curse do we experience, witness or are made aware of each day?
2. In studying the curse on Sunday morning and in reading it now is there anything that you hadn't noticed before or that speaks to you afresh?
3. Romans 5:20 says "*But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more*". What in this passage points to our salvation and God's grace? (The pastor can identify at least three :)
4. Theologically, Adam and Jesus are our 'federal representatives' as what happened to them affects us because of our identification with them. In what ways are the first Adam and the last Adam similar and in what ways are they different? Discuss first then read Romans 5:12 – 21 and 1 Corinthians 15:20 – 28, 42 – 49).
5. Our passage in Genesis 3 finishes with Adam and Eve cast out of the Garden of Eden and cut off from access to the Tree of Life. Read Revelation 22:1 – 5. What encouragement do you take from this today and what do you look forward to most about heaven?
6. How can we use truths that we've spoken of tonight to minister to others?
