



CALVARY LIFE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: Genesis 4 'Sin Pounces'
THEME/S: Sacrifice, Sin, Separation

1. What speaks to you from this passage and are there any questions that arise in your mind as you read it?
2. Why was Abel's sacrifice accepted and Cain's sacrifice not accepted?
3. What sacrifice is acceptable to God today? And what does God look for from us?
4. What do these verses teach us about sin? And what spiritual and practical steps can we take to guard against sin?
5. Are you your brother's keeper?
6. In verses 16 – 25 we see a contrast between the line of godless Cain and the line of godly Seth who was appointed instead of Abel. Consider also the contrast in the New Testament between Abel and Cain – read:
 - Abel – Matthew 23:31 – 36; Hebrews 11:4; Hebrews 12:18 – 24.
 - Cain – Jude 11; 1 John 3:10 – 15.
7. What do you take away from tonight's passage?
