PASSAGE: Genesis 13 'Circumstantial Evidence'

THEME/S: Conflict, Calling & Circumstance

1. What are you like at conflict resolution? Either where you have an issue with someone or someone has an issue with you.
2. What was the conflict in this passage and how did Abram deal with it?
3. Note the contrast between Lot's eyes in verse 10 and Abram's eyes in verse 14. What spiritual applications can we take from this?
4. To what extent was Abram directed and led by God's calling or by circumstance?
5. When it comes to direction and leading, how has God tended to work in your life? Whether by clear calling and hearing His voice or through circumstance or a combination of both.
6. What do the following three passages teach us about God's direction and leading?
 - Psalm 37:3 – 5
 - Proverbs 3:5 – 6
 - Romans 12:1 – 2
