PASSAGE: Genesis 25 'Two and the Stew'

THEME/S: Prayer and Priorities

1. What events or situations in life make you aware of how quickly time passes on by?

Read Genesis 25:1 – 23

2. Abraham lived a long and full life on this earth, however, in the eternal sense his life was but a moment, a breath. How would you eulogise Abraham's life? Or how would you briefly summarise or characterise him?
3. What at times keeps you from praying and what causes you to pray?
4. In verses 20 – 23 we see that both Isaac and Rebekah were people of prayer. What caused them each to pray, how did God answer their prayers and what can we learn from this?

Read Genesis 25:24 – 34

5. What speaks to you, challenges you or raises questions in your mind from these verses?
6. In what ways were Esau's and Jacob's character and priorities shown by their actions?
7. C T Studd, English cricketer and missionary, said "*Only one life, 'twill soon be past, only what's done for Christ will last*". How do we know if our priorities in life are rightly aligned with God's and what can we do to better align them when required?
